

**Mooloolaba Transport Corridor
Upgrade (MTCU) Project**
Stage 1b – Walan Street, Mooloolaba

Night works – Walan Street, Mooloolaba
**Thursday 17 December 6pm – 6am Asphalt (bitumen) surfacing and
light pole installation**
Monday 21 December 6pm – 6am Line marking
(all works weather and site conditions permitting)

With two lanes of Walan Street now open to traffic, construction works are focused on the two additional lanes that will make up the final upgraded four lane road (two lanes each way).

The four-lane Walan Street, including the new signalised Walan Street-Naroo Court intersection is expected to open to traffic by March/April 2021.

Asphalt works and light pole installation

On Thursday 17 December between 6pm and 6am, asphalt (bitumen) will be applied to the new inside southbound lane on Walan Street, between Naroo Court and Smith Street. The asphalt will be applied within the construction zone, with Walan Street remaining open to through traffic.

The construction team will take the opportunity to install some light poles and traffic signal infrastructure on the same evening.

Line marking works

On Monday 21 December between 6pm – 6am, temporary line marking will take place along Walan Street. This will remain in place until the permanent line marking is completed in March/April 2021.

During the asphalt, light pole and line marking works, vehicle and pedestrian access will remain along Walan Street under traffic control. Detours may be in place at times. Please allow an extra ten minutes of travel time.

These works must be undertaken at night, given the significant traffic volumes on Walan Street during the day, and businesses operating nearby.

What to expect during these works

On Thursday 17 December, residents and nearby businesses should expect medium-level construction noise throughout the evening. Additional truck movements in local streets will be experienced as asphalt trucks arrive and depart from the construction site and light poles are delivered and installed.

Lighting and reversing beepers are required for safety.

For residents sensitive to the smell of asphalt, please close all windows and doors and turn on internal fans or air-conditioning. Any odours should dissipate within 24 hours.

Signage and traffic controllers will be present. Emergency vehicle access will remain in all areas under traffic control.

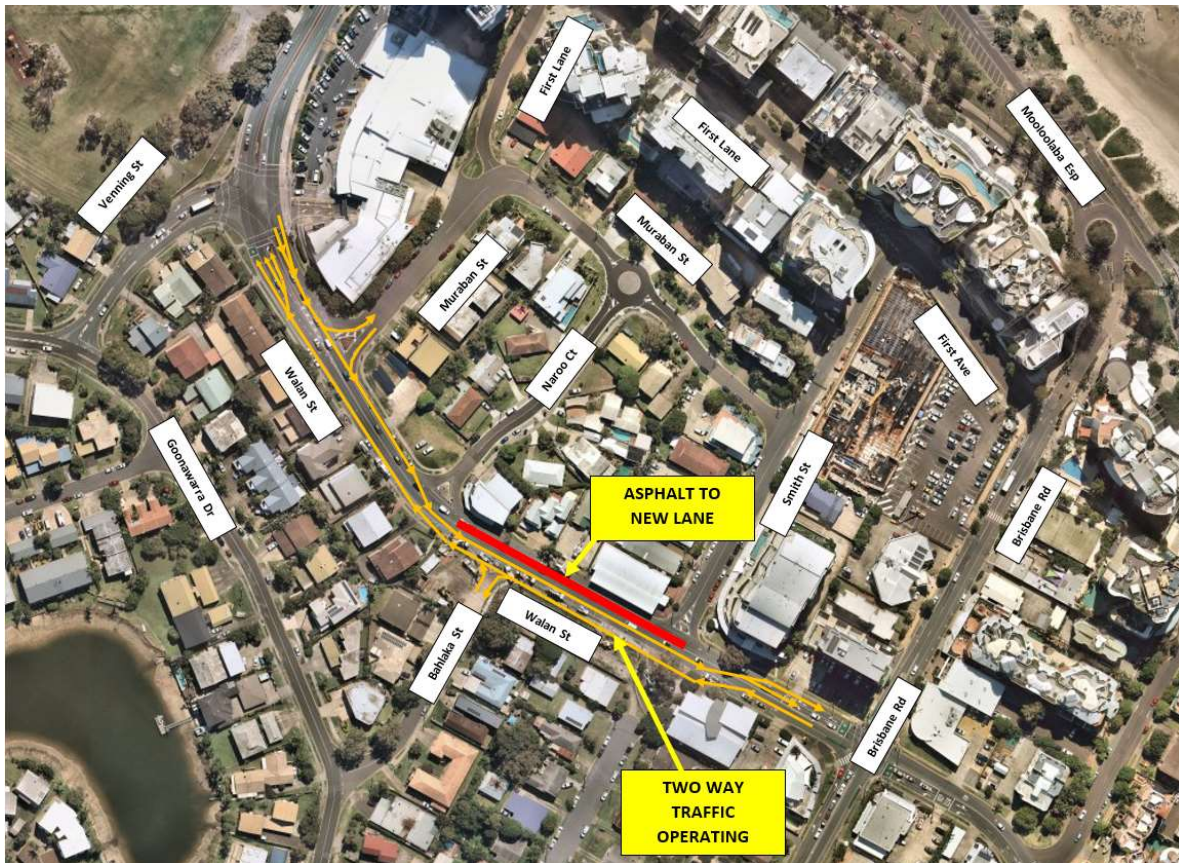
On Monday 21 December, line marking is expected to generate low-level construction noise only.
