Notice to residents

Vegetation clearing – Friday 14 February 2020, 7am – midday.
(weather & site conditions permitting)

As part of the Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade (MTCU) and to accommodate the road widening of Walan Street between Venning Street and Smith Street, some vegetation must be removed on vacant land along Walan Street. Please refer to figure 1 for locations.

Where feasible, trees will be relocated. Where not feasible, offset planting will replace any vegetation removed and additional trees, plants and footpath upgrades will form part of the landscaping design for the project.

Landscaping is recognised as a feature to enhance the entry to Mooloolaba and provide an inviting and attractive space for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists.

Works schedule

The removal of vegetation will take place on Friday 14 February between 7am and 12 noon, weather and site conditions permitting.

These works will involve the use of chain saws and heavy machinery including a wood chipper.

What to expect during construction works

Residents and nearby businesses should expect intermittent, medium-high level noise impacts. For safety reasons, pedestrian traffic will be diverted to alternative footpath routes where required.
