Notice to residents

**Night works and temporary changes to traffic conditions –
Thursday 20 February 2020, 6pm – 6am.**
(Weather & site conditions permitting.)

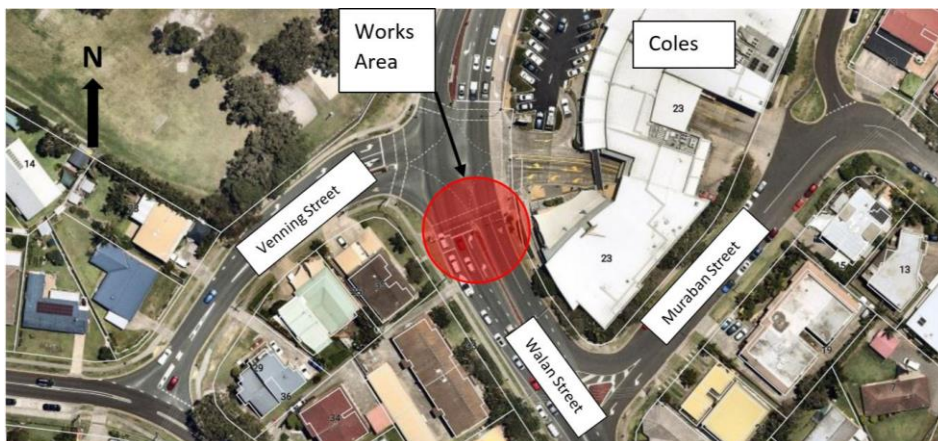


Figure 1: Temporary changes to traffic conditions, Walan Street, 20 February 2020

As part of the Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade (MTCU) and the road widening of Walan Street between Venning Street and Smith Street, night works will occur on Thursday 20 February to detect underground services location along Walan Street. Please refer to figure 1.

For safety reasons, and to minimise inconvenience to residents and businesses, some temporary changes to traffic conditions are required during these works.

Signage and traffic controllers will be present during the works.

Access to driveways along Walan Street will remain available and traffic controllers will assist motorists as required.

Works schedule

These works will take place on Thursday 20 February between 6pm and 6am, weather and site conditions permitting.

What we are doing during these works

Specialist contractors will use advanced surveying methods and vacuum excavation to accurately locate the exact location and depth of the underground services.

What to expect during construction works

Residents and nearby businesses should expect intermittent, low-medium level noise impacts. For safety reasons, pedestrian traffic will be diverted to alternative footpath routes where required.
