

Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade (MTCU) Project

Walan Street – service investigation works Monday 9 September – Friday 13 September (weather permitting)

Service investigation works – Walan Street

As part of the Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade (MTCU) project it is necessary to identify the location and condition of underground services including Telstra, Energex and Unitywater.

These investigations will take place between Monday 9 September and Friday 13 September in various locations in and around Walan Street.

These works form an important part of preparations for the future 4-lane road widening of Walan Street, along with the signalisation of the Walan Street-Naroo Court intersection next year (2020)

What to expect during these works

Investigation works will generally be carried out between 7:00am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday.

Workers will be using earth vacuum equipment on the road verge (the area between the roadway and footpath) to locate the necessary services.

In some cases, temporary traffic management may be required however these works are not expected to have any major impacts on pedestrians, residents, businesses or motorists.

Disruptions to services are not expected.

Some on-street parking in Walan Street may be temporarily affected for short periods of time.

Pedestrian traffic will be diverted to alternative footpath routes where necessary.

The project team will liaise with directly affected residents and businesses if required.
