

**Mooloolaba Transport Corridor
Upgrade (MTCU) Project**
Stage 1b – Walan Street, Mooloolaba

Notice to businesses and residents
Smith Street temporary road closure and night works
Thursday 3 September. Night works 6.30pm – 6am
(weather & site conditions permitting)**Water main upgrade**

As part of the MTCU project, water main infrastructure is being upgraded. This will ensure the water main network continues to work effectively and efficiently.

A new water main must be installed across Smith Street, near the intersection of Walan Street.

For safety reasons and to minimise inconvenience to businesses and residents, these works must be undertaken at night.

In preparation for these works and to minimise noise impacts for residents, some preliminary saw cutting of the road surface will be undertaken during the day.

What we are doing during these works

A section of the road surface will be cut and removed.

A large trench will be dug for the water main pipe to be placed into.

The trench will then be filled in, and asphalt (bitumen) reinstated on the road. A permanent asphalt layer will be applied at the end of the project.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Day works: Smith Street will remain open to traffic during saw cutting works of the road surface. Traffic control will be in place. Intermittent, medium level noise impacts are expected.

Night works: From 6.30pm – 6.00am Smith Street will be closed to all non-local vehicle traffic from Brisbane Road and Walan Street. Detours will be in place via First Avenue. Local access will remain available for residents and businesses of Smith Street via traffic control (from First Avenue).

What to expect during these works

Audible noise: Heavy machinery will be in use. Nearby residents should expect some audible noise. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement. Where possible, noisier works will be undertaken earlier in the evening.

Traffic control and changes to traffic conditions: Changes to traffic conditions including temporary road and lane closures and reduced speed limits will be in place.

Temporary lighting: Generator powered lighting towers will be used to light work areas. Lighting is a safety requirement.

Emergency vehicle access: Emergency access will remain available to homes and businesses under traffic control.
