

Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade (MTCU) Project

Project number: P-H3747

REVISED Water main works – 16, 18 & 20 Walan St
26 October to mid November 2020. 6.30am – 6pm
(weather & site conditions permitting)

Works overview

As part of the MTCU project the water supply and stormwater infrastructure is being relocated and upgraded. This will ensure the water and stormwater network continues to work effectively and efficiently.

New water main and stormwater pipes will be installed in the public road corridor along Walan Street and near the Naroo Court intersection.

No interruption to water supply is expected.

What we are doing during these works

The new water main and stormwater pipes will be installed underground. Areas of the footpath, road verge and driveways will be cut, and a trench dug to accommodate the pipe.

Where driveways are impacted, alternative parking will be provided for businesses.

After the pipes are installed the trench will be infilled with a temporary surface until a new permanent surface is applied later in the construction program. This temporary arrangement is expected to be in place for 1-2 months.

Works schedule

Monday 26 and Tuesday 27 October
16 and 18 Walan Street
Trench cutting across driveways - water main installation

A trench will be cut across the driveway for installation of a new water main. Driveway and car park access will not be available however alternative parking for residents and businesses will be provided on Walan Street. Pedestrian access will remain available to businesses of 16 and 18 Walan Street via alternative pathways.

Monday 26 October - mid November
20 Walan Street
Water main installation

A large trench will be cut under the existing pedestrian pathway on public land. Vehicle access will remain to 20 Walan Street during these works.

Pedestrian access will remain available to businesses of 20 Walan Street via alternative pathways.

For safety reasons the awning of the building will be propped during these works.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Intermittent temporary traffic management will be required to permit large vehicles and machinery to safely enter and exit the sites.

Pedestrian traffic will be diverted to alternative footpath routes where required
