Notice to residents & businesses
Road resurfacing & asphalt works, Walan Street & Smith Street
Monday 23 – Thursday 26 November. 6am – 6am. Day and night works.
(weather & site conditions permitting)**Road resurfacing works**

As part of the Walan Street upgrade works, the road will be resealed. This involves the installation of multiple layers of road material which is then compacted, followed by line marking.

The first layers of asphalt (bitumen) will be installed next week. The final asphalt layer and permanent line marking will take place in the near future. We will keep you informed.

DAY WORKS**Monday 23 November. 6am – 12noon.**
Smith Street and Walan Street intersection.

Asphalt (bitumen) resealing works will be conducted at the intersection of Smith and Walan Streets.

NIGHT WORKS**Monday 23 November 7pm to Thursday 26
November 6am.**
Walan Street and Smith Streets.

To complete the initial asphalt works as quickly and safely as possible and minimise impacts to residents and local businesses, works will also be undertaken over three consecutive nights on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

The roads will reopen to through-traffic by 6am Thursday, 26 November.

**Walan Street-Smith Street intersection
closure**

From Monday 6am to Thursday 6am (24hrs a day), the Smith Street and Walan Street intersection will be closed from Brisbane Road.

Detours will be in place via First Avenue.

The already closed to through-traffic section of Walan Street will remain closed during these works.

Access for residents and businesses on Smith Street and Walan Street will remain under traffic control.

Vehicles must be removed from on-street parking during these works. The construction team will liaise with directly affected residents and businesses.

What to expect during these works?

Large machinery will be in operation.

During night works, lighting towers will be in use for safety reasons. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement.

These works are expected to generate medium – high level intermittent noise.

The construction team will try to mitigate noise impacts wherever possible and safe to do so.

For residents sensitive to the smell of asphalt, please close all windows and doors and turn on internal fans or air-conditioning. Any odours should dissipate within 24 hours.

Emergency vehicle access

Emergency vehicle access will remain in all areas under traffic control.
