Planning for future stages

As part of the Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade (MTCU) and the road widening of Brisbane Road, some geotechnical investigation works for Stage 4 are required.

Stage 4 includes the area from Brisbane Road near Bindaree Crescent to Culbara Street including Tuckers Creek Bridge and features:

- upgrading the road to four traffic lanes
- upgrading the intersection of Brisbane Road/Woomba Place/Bindaree Crescent to a signalised intersection

Stage 4 Construction will take place in 2022 - 2023.

Geotechnical investigations

Monday 1 June 6pm – 5am

Geotechnical investigations are performed to obtain information about the existing ground conditions beneath existing and future structures.

As part of Stage 4 design planning, small holes will be drilled into the northbound side of the road surface of Brisbane Road, south of Tuckers Creek Bridge. The road surface will then be reinstated.

To minimise inconvenience to the community, works will take place at night, between 6pm and 5am.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Brisbane Road and Tuckers Creek Bridge will remain open to vehicle traffic during these works. For safety reasons, lanes will be narrowed when required with traffic control in place.

The bus stop on the southern side of the bridge will remain operational.

Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel time on this evening.

What to expect during construction works

Intermittent noise impacts can be expected during the geotechnical drilling works.
