

**Mooloolaba Transport Corridor

**Notice to businesses and residents**  
**Walan Street temporary road closure and night works**  
**Thursday 2 July. Day works 7am – 5pm. Night works 6.30pm – 5am**  
(weather & site conditions permitting)**Stormwater upgrade**

As part of the MTCU project, stormwater infrastructure is being upgraded. This will ensure the stormwater network continues to work effectively and efficiently.

A new stormwater culvert (a structure that allows water to flow under a road) will be installed across Walan Street.

For safety reasons and to minimise inconvenience to businesses and residents, these works must be undertaken at night.

In preparation for these works and to minimise night noise impacts for residents, some preliminary saw cutting of the road surface will be undertaken across Walan Street during the day.

Please see the map on page 2 for the location of these works.

**What we are doing during these works**

A section of the road surface will be cut and removed. A large trench will be dug for the stormwater pipe to be placed into.

The trench will then be filled in, and asphalt (bitumen) reinstated on the road. The permanent asphalt layer will be applied at the end of the project.

**Temporary changes to traffic conditions**

**Day works:** From 7am – 5pm short term temporary lane closures will apply while construction workers cut across the road surface. Stop and go traffic control will be in place. Access to properties will remain under traffic control. Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel time.

**Night works:** From 6.30pm – 5.00am Walan Street will be closed to all vehicle traffic from Venning Street to Brisbane Road. Detours will be in place via Venning Street - Goonawarra Drive and Brisbane Rd - Mooloolaba Esplanade.

Signage and traffic control will help to redirect motorists. Residents within the closed Walan Street road section will maintain access to their homes under traffic control.

**What to expect during these works**

**Audible noise:** Heavy machinery will be in use and nearby residents should expect some audible noise. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement. Where possible, noisier works will be undertaken earlier in the evening.

**Traffic control and changes to traffic conditions:** Changes to traffic conditions including reduced speed limits and temporary lane and road closures will be in place.

**Temporary lighting:** Generator powered lighting towers will be used to light work areas. Lighting is a safety requirement.

**Emergency vehicle access:** Emergency access will remain available to homes and businesses under traffic control.
