Cribb Street Streetscape

Notice to businesses and residents

Stage 1 Construction 14 April – late October 2020

(weather and site conditions permitting)

Stage 1 works for the \$3.3million Cribb Street upgrade are soon to start. Works include:

- footpath widening and new pavement areas (most existing pavers will be retained with only footpath edging renewed)
- additional landscaping, including new street trees and furniture at key areas
- raised pedestrian crossings with lighting
- parking reconfiguration - parking bays will change from parallel to 90-degree parking on the park side of Cribb Street
- interpretive signage and public artwork

Stage 1 Construction schedule and approach

To minimise inconvenience to residents and businesses, Stage 1 Construction will be staged and separated into five zones, 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D & 1E.

Construction hours will generally be Monday to Friday, from 7am to 5pm. Occasionally some night and Saturday works will be required. The project team will advise adjacent businesses and residents in advance of out-of-hours works.

As Cribb Street is upgraded, businesses and residents can expect some inconvenience during construction including intermittent construction noise, reduced speed limits and changes to traffic conditions. Vehicle and pedestrian access will remain along Cribb Street.

The project team is liaising directly with adjacent residents and businesses to keep them informed and assist them with forward planning and communication to family, friends, customers and staff.

Zone 1A works. 14 April – mid May 2020. Railway side of Cribb Street from opposite Buck's Bakery to north of railway station car park/Mill Street intersection.

Construction will include road and kerb works, reconfigured car parks, garden areas, footpath and lighting works.

Temporary changes to parking and traffic conditions

Parking: For safety reasons, some on-street parking bays will be temporarily unavailable during construction. The project team will keep the maximum number of bays open.

One-way traffic: Part Cribb Street

For safety reasons, Cribb Street traffic will be temporarily changed from two-way to one-way traffic only from north of the railway station car park/Mill Street intersection to Gympie Street North. Access from Gympie Street North into Cribb Street will not be possible. Detours will be in place.

Signage and traffic control will direct motorists.

Vehicle access to businesses and residences will remain.


