### Cribb Street Streetscape

#### Notice to residents and businesses.

### RESCHEDULED Night works Thursday 29 October 8pm – 6am and kerb and paving works (weather and site conditions permitting)

As part of Stage 1 works for the \$3.3million Cribb Street upgrade, some night works are required.

The night works originally scheduled for last Thursday 22 October were cancelled due to poor weather. They have now been rescheduled for this **Thursday 29 October from 8pm to 6am at the Maleny Street / Cribb Street intersection.**

This work will involve the excavation and reconstruction of the road. Vehicle access to Cribb Street will remain under traffic control.

#### What to expect during these night works?

**Audible noise:** Heavy machinery will be in use and nearby residents should expect some audible noise. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement.

#### Traffic control and changes to traffic conditions:

Temporary changes to traffic conditions including reduced speed limits. Vehicle entry into Cribb Street will remain as guided by traffic controllers.

#### Kerb and paving works – late October to early November 2020

To improve the footpath cross-fall (slope from shop to kerb) and ensure the footpath is safer for all users, Council intends to change the kerb profile. This will include the lifting and re-laying of the existing pavers from the old Bank building to the butcher shop

All elements, such as parking, gardens and street furniture, will be located as per the proposed streetscape design.

Kerb works will take place this week, followed by the paving works in early November. The paving work will be undertaken at night to minimise impacts to businesses and the broader community. Minimal noise impacts are expected.
