Night works

As advised in our previous Construction Notification of 3 November 2020, night works have been scheduled to take place over multiple evenings (weather and site conditions permitting).

Revised dates for these night works are as follows:

**Thursday 12 – Sunday 22 November
(excluding Friday and Saturday evenings)**
Paving and verge works along Cribb Street

Tuesday 17 November 5pm – 5am
Asphalt (bitumen) road resurfacing works.

Traffic control and the current temporary one-way traffic and detour routes will be in place as required.

Temporary changes to parking and traffic conditions

To ensure safe access for final construction works, the current one-way Cribb Street traffic arrangement will remain in place until early December 2020.

Shop side parking, between the Butcher and CJ's Bakery, will be open from week beginning Monday 23 November.

Landscaping plans and vegetation removal

Landscaping activity will continue along Cribb Street over the next few weeks.

Some 33 new trees and 1800 plants will be planted as part of the project. Species have been selected to suit the local conditions and reflect the character of the street.

Five existing trees on public land, on the railway side of Cribb Street, must be removed to accommodate the new design. These trees are also impacting on existing underground electrical and water main infrastructure.

To minimise inconvenience to the community, this vegetation removal will take place as part of the upcoming night works (weather and site conditions permitting). The use of chain saws and heavy machinery will be required.
