Notice to residents and businesses

Northern precinct of the Mooloolaba foreshore – Site establishment and seawall upgrade

Tuesday, 6 October – early February 2021

As part of the Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation project the northern precinct is being transformed into a new regional public parkland that celebrates the Sunshine Coast way of life.

Stage 1 Northern Parkland will include a new boardwalk linking Alexandra Headland Bluff and Mooloolaba, parks and entertainment spaces for events, replacement of the seawall, a sheltered barbecue area and new community buildings and facilities.

Stage 1 of the Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation Project is expected to be completed by mid-2021, weather and site conditions permitting.

Construction hours will primarily be between 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Friday.

What's coming up?

Site establishment | 6-9 October 2020

Initial works to establish the construction site will include installing temporary project fencing, establishing workers facilities, delivering large machinery and service location works.

Seawall upgrade | 12 October - Feb 2021

Construction works for the seawall are scheduled to start in early October and be completed in early February 2021, weather and site conditions permitting.

Construction works will be undertaken by Council.

What to expect during these works?

Residents and nearby businesses should expect intermittent, low-medium level noise impacts.

Some temporary changes to traffic conditions are required during these periods.

Signage and traffic controllers will be present during the works.

To facilitate the site establishment, including the safe delivery of materials required for the project, the temporary Mooloolaba Beach car park will be temporarily closed on Tuesday, 6 October between 4- 11am. Once reopened this temporary car park will still be available to the public during construction, albeit overall capacity will be reduced and will fluctuate due to construction footprints.

For safety reasons and to minimise impacts to residents and businesses, movement of large construction equipment and machinery are scheduled for Tuesday, 6 October and Friday, 9 October between 4- 6am.

During the seawall construction, the local community may experience increased construction traffic entering and exiting the work area.

Dust mitigation measures will be in place.

Every effort will be made to minimise construction impacts where possible.
