### Notice to residents and businesses

### Vegetation clearing for seawall construction

Thursday, 29 October, weather and site conditions permitting

As part of Stage 1 Northern Parkland and to accommodate the seawall upgrade, some existing trees must be removed along the foreshore.

Offset planting will replace any vegetation removed and additional trees and plants will form part of the landscaping design for the project.

The completed project will see extensive new planting and landscaping with almost 50 new trees and over 1000 plants to be planted as part of the project.

#### Works schedule

The removal of vegetation will take place over the next week, weather and site conditions permitting.

These works will involve the use of chain saws and heavy machinery including a wood chipper.

#### What to expect during these works?

Residents and nearby businesses should expect intermittent, medium-high level noise impacts. For safety reasons, pedestrian traffic will be diverted to alternative footpath routes where required.
