As per our previous construction notification (22 April) a major upgrade to the Parklands Boulevard – Meridan Way intersection is underway.

The traffic signals at the intersection will remain turned off.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions**Access to Meridan Way**

To coincide with the return of all students to school on Monday 25 May, vehicle traffic will be able to access Meridan Way from/to Parklands Boulevard under a left in, left out only arrangement.

Detour signage and road barriers will be in place to assist motorists. Reduced speed limits will apply.

Pedestrian and cycle access will remain to the Meridan State College via Parklands Boulevard and Meridan Way.

Vehicles can continue to travel along Parklands Boulevard with one lane of traffic operating in each direction.

Full reopening of Meridan Way

We will be in touch again soon to advise when the fully upgraded and complete Meridan Way intersection will reopen.

This is anticipated to take place in early June (weather and site conditions permitting)

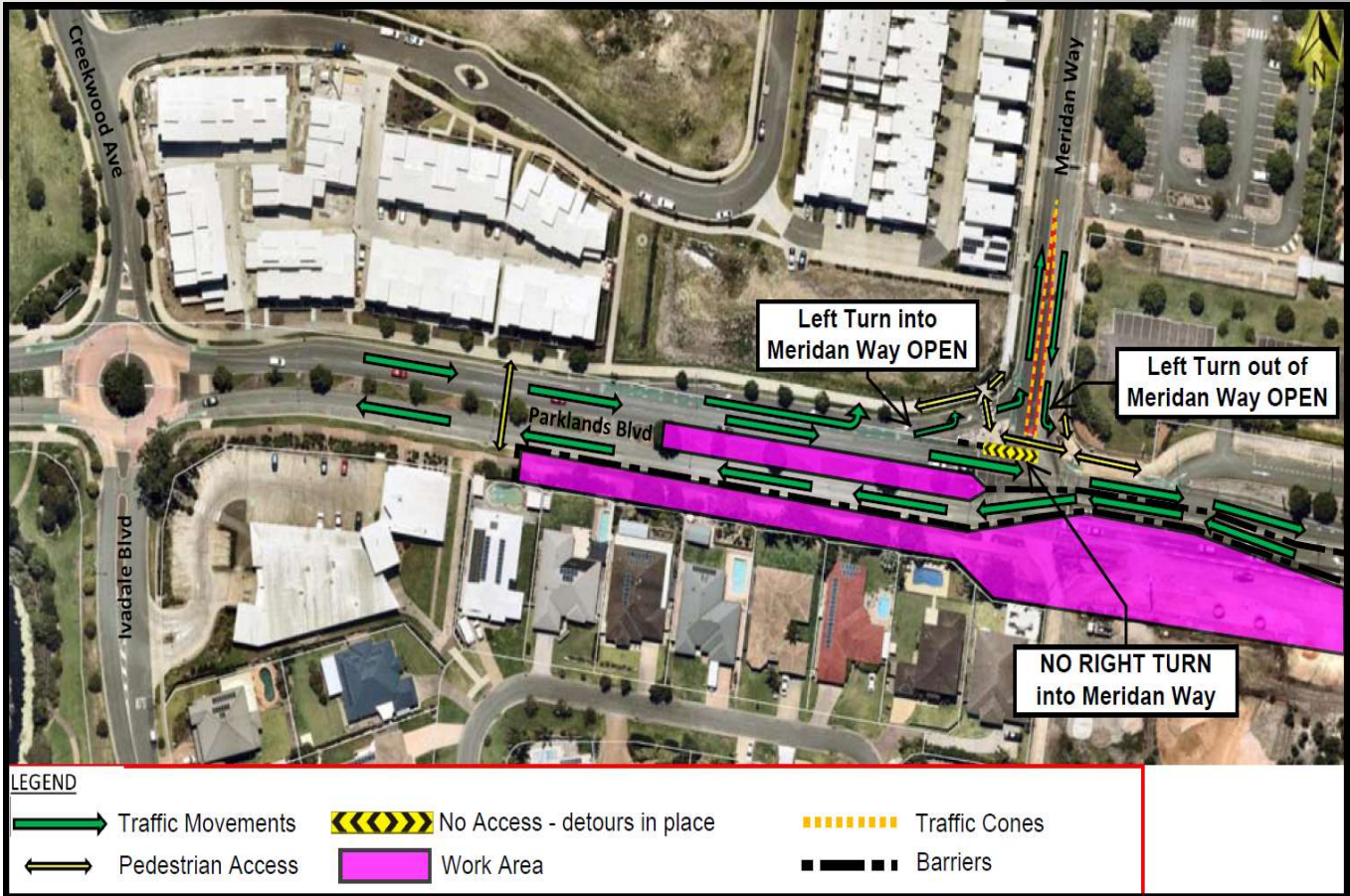


Figure 1. Details of temporary changes to traffic movements – Meridan Way – Parklands Boulevard intersection Monday 25 May
