

Parklands Boulevard Upgrade Meridan Plains

Temporary changes to traffic conditions (weather and site conditions permitting)

Partial closure of Meridan Way Intersection Tuesday 28 April to Sunday 24 May 2020

The next phase of Stage 2 Parklands Boulevard Upgrade will soon start at the Parklands Boulevard and Meridan Way intersection, next week.

Council will be working closely with the contractor to ensure the safety of staff and the community is maintained during the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Working arrangements will adhere to national public health directions, and strategies used to mitigate delays wherever possible. The project team will undertake extensive construction works in and around the intersection including:

- mains water and stormwater
- electrical works for new traffic signals and street lighting
- major road works including road widening and kerb works

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Council aims to complete these works as safely and quickly as possible to minimise inconvenience to the community. Part of Meridan Way will be closed to vehicle traffic from midnight Tuesday 28 April to midnight Sunday 24 May 2020. Detours will be in place via Creekwood Avenue and Hamilton Street.

Alternate vehicle access will remain in place for Meridan State College and local residences, including pedestrian access.

Traffic lights will be turned off at the Parklands Boulevard and Meridan Way intersection.

Vehicle access will remain along Parklands Boulevard with one lane of traffic operating in each direction.

Reduced speed limits will apply and road barriers and signage will assist with redirecting motorists.

Emergency service vehicle access will remain available to homes and businesses.

The project team will continue to monitor the State and Federal government directives around schools and businesses. Should changes take place prior to Sunday 24 May, further modifications will be made to traffic conditions.




Figure 1. Location of major construction area and details of temporary changes to traffic movements.
