Russell Family Park gravel car park NOW OPEN

Gravel car park now open

The Russell Family Park gravel car park has been reopened to vehicles today (16 March 2018).

The gravel car park will remain open until Stage 2 construction commences on 9 April 2018 as below. The carpark adjacent to the Clock Shop will remain open throughout Stage 2 works.

Stage 2: 9 April – early August. Car park construction (gravel car park closed for safety reasons).
**All construction dates and works are weather permitting.*

Pedestrian access will remain to the park, and to the public amenities building adjacent to the gravel car park.

About the car park upgrade

The upgrade of the Russell Family Park car park forms part of the 2001 Russell Family Park Master Plan.

The car park upgrade will include:

- provision for approximately 125, line-marked car parking bays (55 more than the current informal, gravel car park)
- additional landscaping including the planting of over 3,300 trees and shrubs (comprising approximately 80 native trees, 16 native palm trees, 812 shrubs and a further 2,400 tube stock plants for revegetation purposes)
- improved access for people of all abilities

- a permeable concrete pavement surface
- improved drainage and stormwater infrastructure.

Car parking and traffic management

For safety reasons the existing gravel car park will be closed during Stage 2 construction works.

Council is continuing to explore alternative car parking options over this period.

We will advise the outcomes of these investigations as soon as possible.

On street parking will remain in Montville Village.

Traffic management measures will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists and construction workers.
