Walan Street final asphalt overlay and line marking works (night works)**Asphalt: Sunday 21 February – Thursday 25 February, 6pm – 6am****Line marking: Sunday 28 February – Monday 1 March, 6pm – 6am****(all works weather and site conditions permitting)****About these works**

As part of the finishing works for the Stage 1B Walan Street upgrade, final asphalt (bitumen) and line marking works are required. To minimise inconvenience to the community these works must take place at night.

Each evening during the asphalt and line marking works, Walan Street will be closed to through-traffic with detours in place. Walan Street will be reopened to through-traffic by 6am each morning.

Residents and staff wishing to access homes or businesses within the works zones will be assisted by traffic control. Please ensure vehicles are not parked along Walan Street on these evenings.

To progress the works as quickly and safely as possible, the Walan Street-Smith Street intersection will remain temporarily closed for three days and nights, from 6pm Sunday 21 February to 6am Thursday 25 February inclusive. It will reopen to traffic by 6am Thursday morning.

Please refer to the onsite signage each evening and follow the directions of traffic controllers. Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel time.

What we are doing

Sunday 21 to Thursday 25 February, 6pm – 6am. Final asphalt (bitumen) overlay works. Some areas of Walan Street will require road surface preparation (grading) before the final layer of asphalt is laid.

Sunday 28 February to Monday 1 March, 6pm – 6am. Line marking the new road surface.

What to expect during these works?

Nearby residents and businesses should expect intermittent medium-level construction noise, particularly on Sunday 21 and Monday 22 February when machinery will be grading some sections of the road surface in preparation for asphaltting.

Large trucks and machinery will be operating. Lighting and reversing beepers are a safety requirement.

Signage will be in place to help direct motorists and traffic control will be in operation.

Changes to traffic conditions will include temporary Walan Street and Smith Street intersection closures with detours in place.

For residents sensitive to the smell of asphalt, please close all windows and doors and turn on internal fans or air-conditioning. Any odours should dissipate within 24 hours.

Please see onsite traffic control for any pedestrian or vehicle access assistance required.
