

Parklands Boulevard Upgrade Meridan Plains

Services relocation and upgrade works

May – July 2019 (weather and site conditions permitting)

Services relocations and upgrades Monday 27 May to mid-July

As part of the delivery of the Parklands Boulevard Upgrade Project, underground relocation of Telstra and Energex services will take place between 27 May and mid July 2019 in various locations across the project site.

Telstra works will take place at the Meridan Way-Parklands Boulevard intersection. Energex works will take place at the Sunset Drive-Parklands Boulevard intersection, including the undergrounding of existing overhead power lines.

The relocation of these services forms an important part of preparations for the permanent relocation of the overhead power lines (in August 2019), before the future four-lane road widening of Parklands Boulevard later this year.

Energex and Telstra will liaise directly with residents and businesses where temporary power or telecommunications outages may occur.

What to expect during these works?

Work will generally take place from 6.30am - 6pm Monday to Saturday. On occasion it may be necessary to complete some work on Sundays. Should this be required, advance notification will be provided.

Medium level, intermittent construction noise can be expected including the temporary removal of some footpath areas, tunnelling under the road

in some areas, minimal clearing of low vegetation (where services are located under garden beds and which will be reinstated at the end of the project), and the cutting and temporary reinstatement of road surfaces.

The construction team will try to mitigate construction impacts in relation to surrounding residents and businesses wherever possible and safe to do so.

Changes to traffic conditions

Pedestrian and vehicle access will remain to the school, businesses and residences along Parklands Boulevard however some temporary changes to pedestrian and traffic movements will be required for safety.

To minimise inconvenience to the community, major changes to traffic conditions will be avoided wherever possible during peak school drop off and pick up times. Traffic control will be in operation to help motorists and pedestrians navigate around the works.

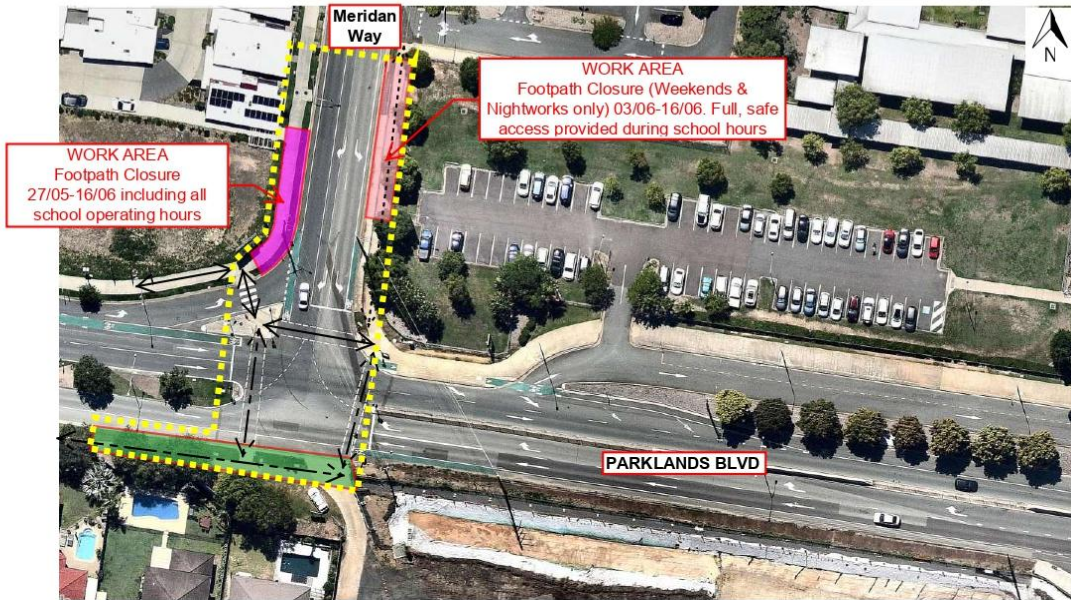


Figure 2 – Energex Relocations at Sunset Drive Intersection
