

**Mooloolaba Transport Corridor

**Notice to residents and businesses
Reopening of Walan Street to through-traffic
Monday 30 November, 5am
(weather & site conditions permitting)**

Council would like to thank the community for its patience and cooperation over the past few months, especially the businesses and residents located near the temporarily closed section of Walan Street, Mooloolaba.

We are pleased to announce that Walan Street between Venning and Smith Streets will reopen to through-traffic on Monday 30 November at 5am.

Temporary changes to local traffic conditions and remaining Stage 1b construction works**Walan Street**

Two lanes of Walan Street will reopen to through-traffic (one lane in each direction).

It is expected that all four lanes of Walan Street (two lanes in each direction) will open in February/March 2021 (weather and site conditions permitting).

With 80% of Stage 1b now complete, the remaining works include finishing the two additional road lanes, drainage, minor kerb works, some water main works, traffic signal operations, landscaping and applying the final layer of road surface and permanent line marking.

Goonawarra Drive detour

This detour will cease by 5am Monday 30 November.

Venning Street intersection

The signalised intersection will reopen by 5am Monday 30 November.

Loading dock entry/exit – Mooloolaba Central Shopping Complex

Large vehicle access to the loading dock will be possible from Walan Street and Muraban Street from 5am Monday 30 November.

Walan Street bus stops

Bus stops temporarily located near Mantra Hotel Mooloolaba will remain at their current locations until February/March 2021. Once the works are completed, they will return to their original locations on Walan Street with new and upgraded bus shelters for passengers.

Naroo Court-Walan Street intersection

For safety reasons, the upgraded intersection cannot be opened until the traffic signals are operating in late December 2020/early January 2021.

Until then, access to residences and businesses in Naroo Court will remain via Smith Street/Muraban Street.

Access to Walan Street and Naroo Court residences and businesses

Some residences and businesses will have temporary driveways and alternative access arrangements operating until all Stage 1b works are complete.

What is next for the Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade Project?

A project newsletter will soon be distributed which will include information about the next stages of the project.

These future stages will see construction activity move onto Brisbane Road and include the new vehicle bridge over Mayes Canal.

Pending the appointment of a successful construction contractor, Stages 2 and 3 are expected to start construction in March/April 2021.

Stage 4 is expected to start construction in 2023.

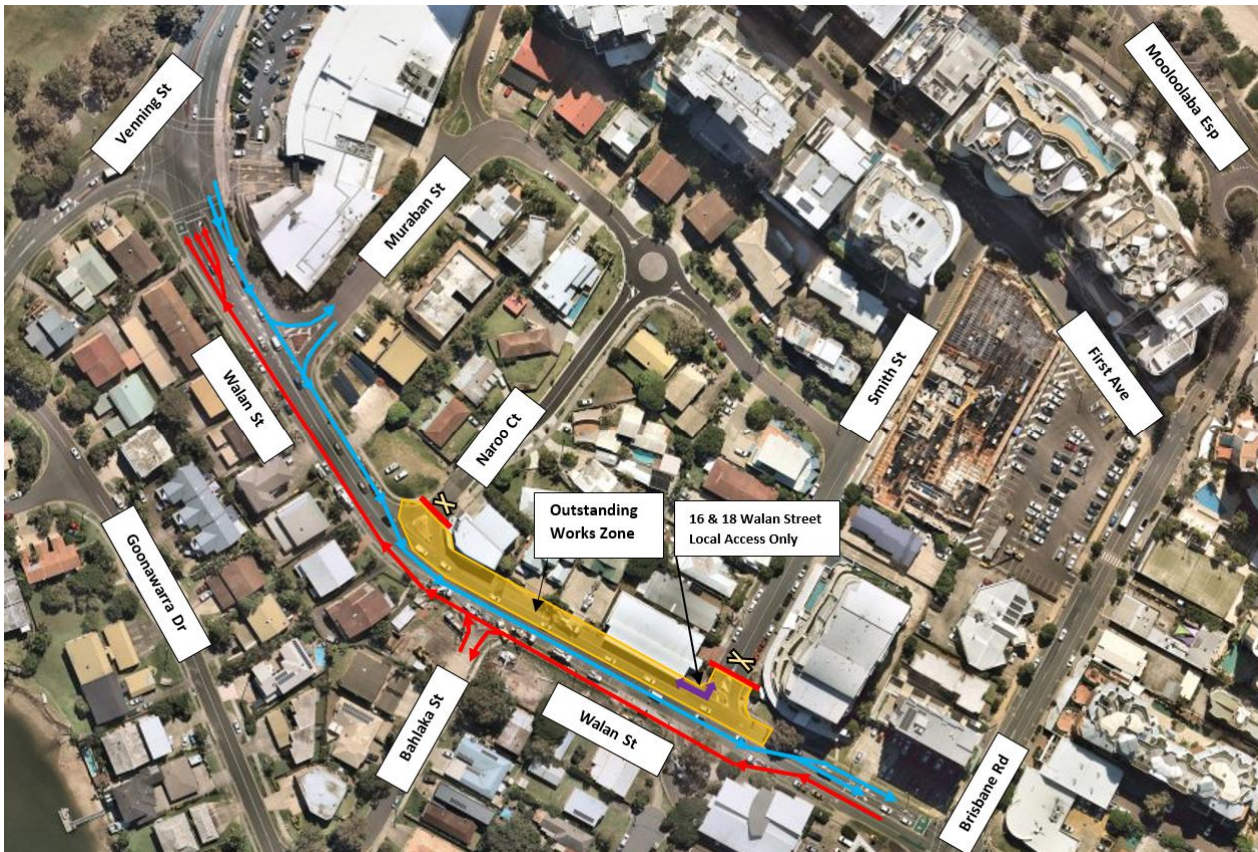


FIGURE 1: TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONDITIONS
