As part of the delivery of the Parklands Boulevard Upgrade Project and in preparation for the upcoming relocation of Energex services, Council must reconstruct a section of the footpath on the southern side of Parklands Boulevard (weather and site conditions permitting).

Temporary changes to pedestrian movements

Pedestrian access across Parklands Boulevard, including the 'lollipop' crossing will remain open at all times.

The southern footpath will remain open during peak drop off and pick up school times.

At other times some intermittent temporary changes to pedestrian movements will be in place. Construction staff will assist pedestrians as required.

What to expect during these works

There will be no construction impacts to motorists.

Medium level, intermittent construction noise can be expected including the cutting and removal of the footpath surface.

The construction team will try to mitigate construction impacts in relation to surrounding residents wherever possible and safe to do so.

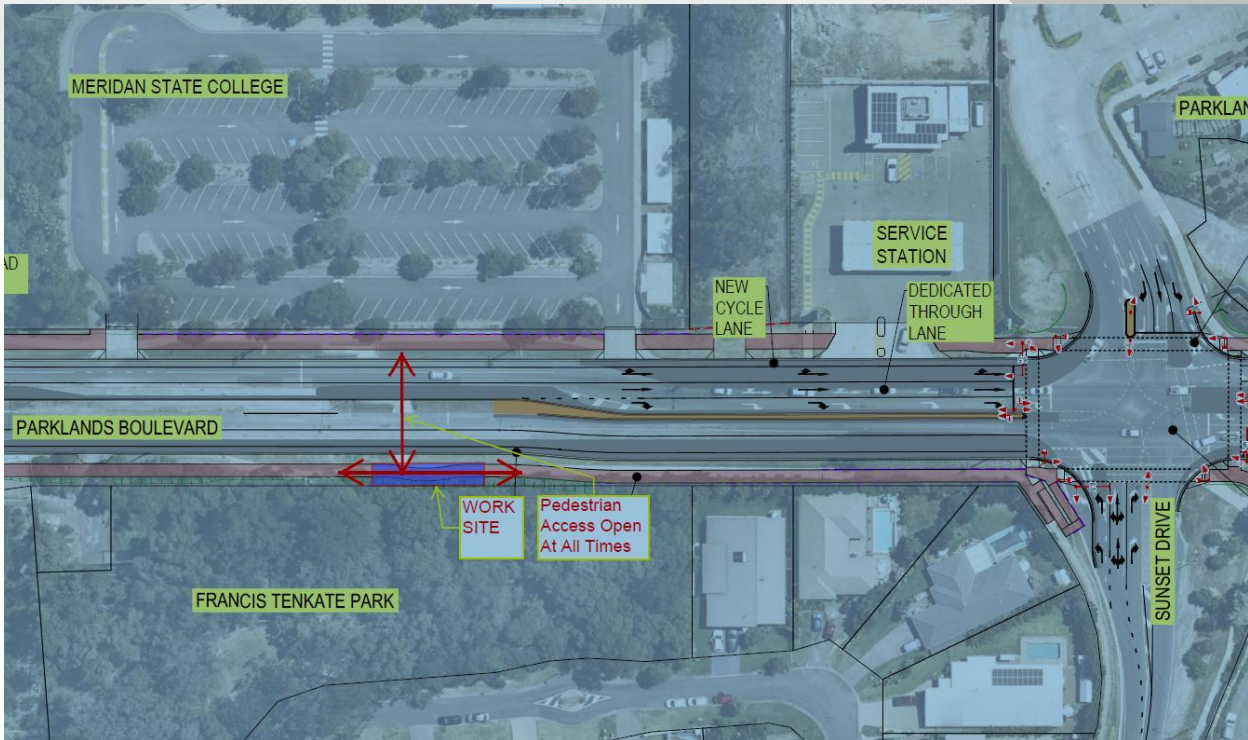


Figure one: Construction area for new footpath works (in purple)
