Car Park to open from 5pm, Friday 27 July - 125 line-marked parking bays available

Upgraded car park to open a week early

Despite frequent wet weather over the past few months, Council is pleased to report that the upgraded car park will be open for public parking a week ahead of schedule, from 5pm, Friday 27 July 2018.

The car park now boasts 125 line-marked parking bays - 55 more bays than the previous gravel car park as well as two disability parking bays.

The new sealed car park surface and storm water upgrade will also make the car park safer for use.

Minor works (including tree planting, landscaping and rock wall construction) will continue throughout late July and August however these works are not expected to impact on public parking.
