December 2020 and January 2021 construction activity

(weather and site conditions permitting)

Progress update

Construction on Stage 1 of the Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation (Northern Parkland) remains on track for completion by mid-2021, weather and site conditions permitting.

Since mid-November, Council and our contractor have progressed work on the seawall (80% completed) and a new permanent beach access mid wall along the seawall, which is now complete and accessible over the Christmas and New Year break.

While the seawall is not yet complete, it is already demonstrating its effectiveness in protecting the land area during the recent storms and rainfall events (see image below).

Construction break over Christmas and New Year

All construction on this project will pause over the Christmas break (18 December – 4 January) to minimise disruption to residents and visitors.

Parking and beach access during the construction break

Parking and the new beach access will be available during the holidays. While some sections of the foreshore will remain closed due to the construction site the following parking spaces will be available during this time:

Temporary Mooloolaba Beach car park - 70 parking spaces

The new **ParknGo Mooloolaba Central car park** (open from 23 December 2020) – 700 parking spaces

Beach Terrace car park – 96 parking spaces

Club Lane car park – 19 parking spaces and eight Surf Life Saving only parking spaces

The Wharf car park – 427 parking spaces

Temporary Brisbane Road car park (fronting Brisbane Rd) – 83 parking spaces

Incana Court car park – 110 parking spaces.

On-street parking is available at various locations throughout Mooloolaba.

What's coming up?

Council will recommence work on the seawall from the week of 4 January 2021. Council's contractor, Murphy Builders, will commence work on the boardwalk and northern parkland early in the new year.

In order to complete the works as quickly as possible, construction will continue throughout the remaining 2021 school holiday periods until August but will exclude public holidays.

What to expect during these works?

Construction hours will primarily be between 6.30am and 6pm, Monday – Friday, weather and site conditions permitting.

Residents and nearby businesses should expect intermittent, low-medium level noise impacts.

Some Saturday works may be required between 7am and 1pm. These works will have reduced noise and truck movements.
