**Notice to residents and motorists
January and mid-February 2021 Seawall construction activity**

Construction works on Stage 1 Northern Parkland of the Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation project are progressing as per schedule and remain on track for completion by mid-2021, weather and site conditions permitting.

Project Update

Since our last construction update in December 2020, Council and our contractor have continued to progress with the seawall replacement works.

The old seawall was partly covered of exotic weed (Singapore Daisy) and built to protect the former holiday park area. The renewed 295 metre seawall will protect the new community parkland and improve resilience to coastal erosion during storms. Over time, it is expected that wind swept sand will fill the seawall crevices and native vegetation may establish.

The new parkland will meet the top of the seawall with landscaped gardens and paths.

The seawall is expected to be completed in mid-February 2021, weather and site conditions permitting.

What's coming up?

Council will progress with the seawall and Council's contractor, Murphy Builders, will soon commence construction works of the new boardwalk and northern parkland. More details of the works on the new parkland will be provided in the next construction update.

Construction hours will primarily be between 6.30am and 6pm, Monday – Friday, weather and site conditions permitting.

Some Saturday works may be required between 7am and 1pm. These works will have reduced noise and truck movements.

As previously advised and coinciding the end of the summer school holidays and the opening of the new 700-space ParknGo Mooloolaba Central car park (formerly Brisbane Road car park) the temporary Mooloolaba Beach car park will close from Monday 1 February 2021.
