Construction overview

Residents and visitors are loving the new boardwalk, viewing platform and stair connections in the Northern Parkland. This new infrastructure was certainly popular during the recent long weekends, Easter and school holidays.

The final elements of the parkland will be constructed throughout May and June (weather permitting), and planning is well underway for a community celebration in July. We will provide more information about the official opening celebrations soon.

Construction activity in May will focus on completing the major structures such as the public amenities and barbecue shelter buildings and the playground.

The new seaview deck and garden areas will then start to take shape.

Some footpath rectification works will take place on the shop side of Mooloolaba Esplanade also.

Although this week's weather forecast is for extensive rain, the project team will continue to progress works wherever safe and possible to do so.

Details of May works (Zone B parkland & shop side of Mooloolaba Esplanade)

Zone B Parkland

- New public amenities and barbecue shelter buildings nearing completion
- Installation of 'street furniture' such as seating, bins and bin enclosures
- New seaview deck construction
- Lighting and electrical works
- Landscaping and planting including new garden areas and feature trees

Shop side

- Footpath rectification works - replacement of the dilapidated stone and concrete circle on the footpath (adjacent to the Mantra entry arcade) with new, level feature coloured concrete. This will involve cutting and removing part of the existing concrete footpath and pouring new concrete footpath. *Refer Figure 1 (over page)*

Pedestrian access will remain available to all businesses and residences
