From a small community organisation founded on the Sunshine Coast 26 years ago, STEPS today deliver a broad range of services across Australia reflecting the diverse needs of the communities they work in. As long time advocates of integrated workplaces, STEPS assist people with disabilities gain work in mainstream employment, and work with local business to break down perceptions around employing people with a disability.

STEPS Education and Training work closely with local industries to ensure local market needs are met developing training courses that provide real skills for work. STEPS training ranges from an International English College, Aged Care and First Aid training on the Sunshine Coast, to Language, Literacy and Numeracy training throughout Australia regionally and remotely.

STEPS' community and social initiatives include, but not exclusively, the provision of in home and community care, social ventures focused on building community and environmental sustainability, and providing critical support to Australia's many unpaid carers.
