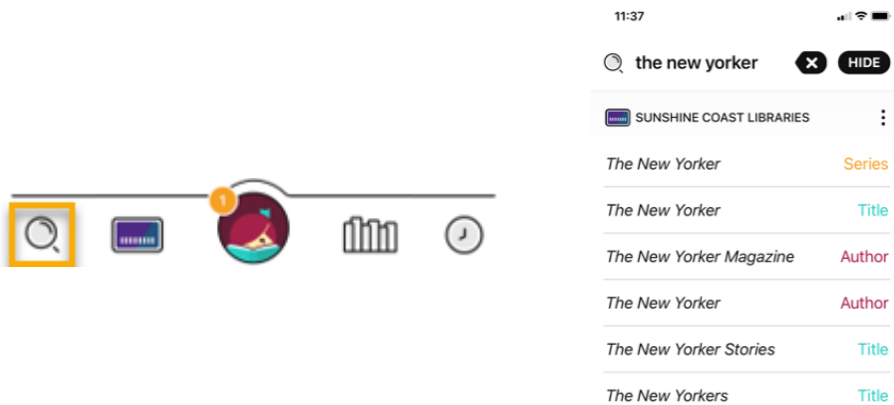


Browsing eMagazines in the Libby app

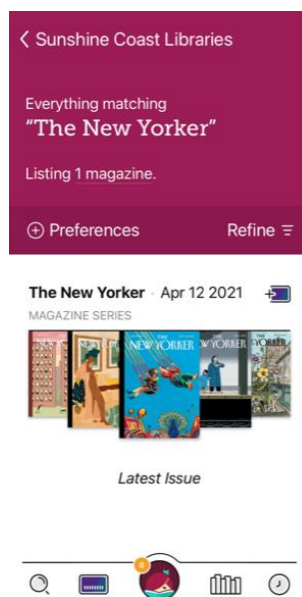

Searching for a specific magazine title in the Libby app:

Tap on the search icon and type in the name of the magazine in the search field (e.g. *The New Yorker*)



The search results will give you the option to view the *series* or *title*. Tapping on either will display all available issues of the magazine (the most recent issue will be featured).



To borrow or read more about an issue, tap on the issue image.



Click *borrow* to loan the magazine or scroll to the bottom of the screen to view other issues or publication information

Browsing all available magazine titles in the Libby app:

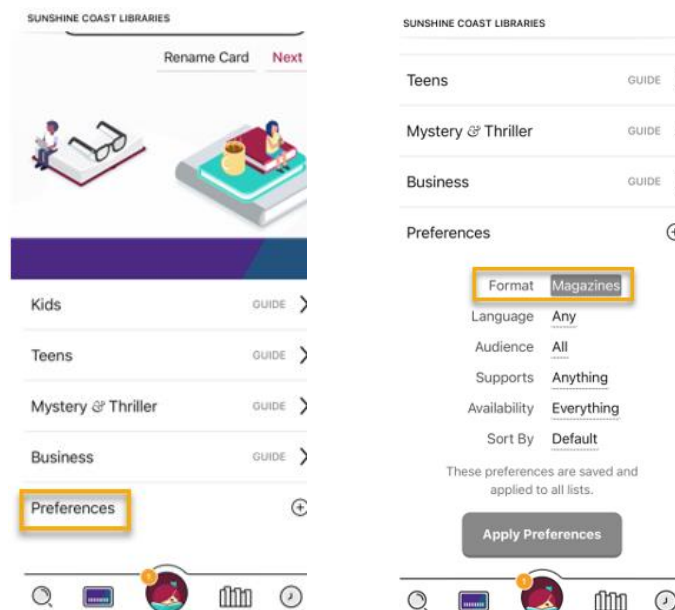
Update your Libby app preferences to only display magazine format titles. You will need to remove the format preference if you want to search other item formats (e.g. eBook or eAudiobooks).

Go to the Libby app home screen (tap on the library card icon next to the search icon)

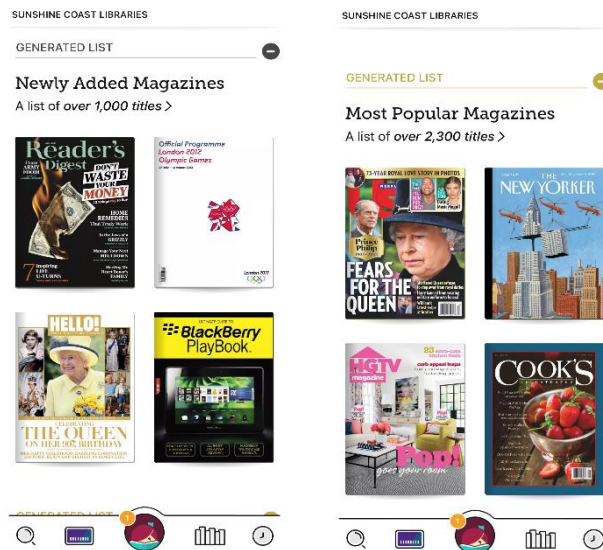
Scroll down the page and tap *Preferences*.

Change to *Format* to magazines

Tap *Apply Preferences* to save the changes

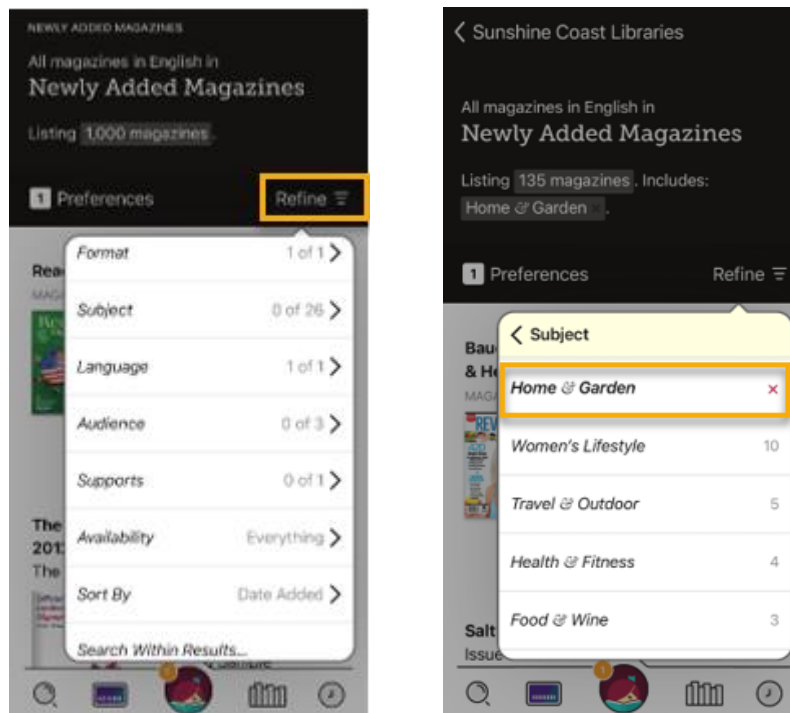


Scroll down the page and tap either the *Newly Added Magazines* or *Most Popular Magazines* category



Use the *Refine* option to search by *subject*, *audience* or *date added*

To remove or change the filter you are browsing, tap *Refine* and then tap the red cross to deselect the original filter applied
